Week TEN Themes: November 30 - December 4, 2015

- COLOR: RED & GREEN please have your child wear as much as possible.
- LETTER: "O", as in otter, octopus, off, oxygen. This is for Pre-K.
- TO STUDY AND PLAY: Leaves, Christmas, Jesus is born
- Miss Filey will lacing Christmas stockings with the MWF class. She will introduce St. Nicolas to both classes. She will be working with the MWF class on drawings for the Christmas book. She will be asking the TTh class what they want for Christmas.
- On Wednesday, Mrs. Zweers will be letting the children roll out cookie dough and making Christmas tree cookies. On Monday and Friday she will have the children hammer a nativity scene. About FOOD ALLERGYIES: No food can come to school with peanuts. If your child has a food allergy, please see Kahleen this week, so we can be sure our lists are up-to-date. Please provide a birthday treat for your child to be kept at school for any celebrations.

Helpful tips for success at school:

- 1. BATHROOM: The children are trying to go to the bathroom on their own, but when there are snaps and zippers, or even really tight fitting elastic in the waste of the pants, it is impossible for them to complete this task alone.
- 2. SHOES: Open shoes allow the sand to get in too easily, and there was some frustration today when the sand just would not stay out. If you have shoes that the child can take off and put on by themselves that is the best for school. Yes, I know, some of those come with all the holes for the sand to get in. Oh well, just think about it. Long shoe laces can get caught in the wheels of the trikes. Velcro and elastic can usually work, but we will help them when needed.

Mrs. Zweers wood projects: Christmas is coming and Mrs. Zweers would love to do some hammering projects with both classes, but we need boards. In order to do this, we need LOTS of 6 inch pine shelving cut in 8inch sections, with the edges sanded so the children don't get splinters. If you are interested, you can just get the boards, cut them and bring them to us. If you are able to do the work, but do not have money for the materials, let me (Kahleen) know. Thanks for any help.

Leaves: As we slide into the Fall, keep an eye out for leaves that are falling off trees in big piles. We love to have big piles of leaves for the children to play in, so we are asking that you bag leaves and bring them to school. Since they will be rolling in the leaves, please do NOT include oak leaves or any other that have sharp pokies on them. Thanks so much!!!
